

Reclaimed Water

How Do I Get Connected?

Use the following checklist to help you through the process:

- ✔ Ensure that reclaimed water is available to your property by contacting the City's Reclaimed Water Coordinator.
- ✔ Obtain 'Application for Reclaimed Water Service' form by contacting the City's Reclaimed Water Coordinator.
- ✔ For multi-family and commercial properties, determine the size of service required to serve the property.
- ✔ Submit application, connection fee and supporting documentation, if necessary, to Reclaimed Water Coordinator.
- ✔ Have approved backflow preventer installed on all drinking water service lines. Submit proof of backflow certification to the City. Ensure that backflow technician is properly certified.
- ✔ Coordinate service and meter installation with Reclaimed Water Coordinator.
- ✔ Install notification signs.
- ✔ New irrigation systems must be color-coded using purple pipe, valve box lids and sprinkler heads. For retrofit properties, please contact the Reclaimed Water Coordinator for color-coding requirements.
- ✔ Have master irrigation system shut off valve installed and consider the need for a pressure regulator. Connect irrigation system to City's reclaimed water meter. For retrofit properties, disconnect irrigation system from existing water source. Leave disconnect visible for inspection.
- ✔ Coordinate cross-connection inspection and service turn-on with Reclaimed Water Coordinator.

What To Consider

- * All drinking water service lines shall have approved backflow devices installed.
- * Reclaimed water can only be used for irrigation of lawn and landscape.
- * Reclaimed water notification signs must be posted at each entrance to the property.
- * Reclaimed water cannot be used to irrigate fruits and vegetables that are not peeled, skinned, cooked or thermally processed before consumption.
- * Above-ground hose bibs on reclaimed water irrigation systems are prohibited.
- * Reclaimed water cannot be piped into any building or dwelling.
- * Reclaimed water irrigation systems, including piping, valve box lids and sprinkler heads, must be color-coded purple.
