

RESOLUTION NO. 3214

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MELBOURNE, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR SOLID WASTE SERVICE RATES AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 14-46 OF THE CITY CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, Section 14-46, City Code, provides a billing procedure for solid waste collection services; and

WHEREAS, Section 14-46(d) provides that the schedule of rates for solid waste services shall be authorized by resolution of the City Council.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MELBOURNE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the following Solid Waste Service rates, which include a \$0.27 sanitation service charge for residential, and a \$0.33 sanitation service charge for commercial, are hereby adopted:

<b>Residential – All units using cans</b>	
Curbside Service	\$6.56
Yard Trash	\$1.24
Recycling	\$2.70
Back-Door Service	Same as above
<b>Commercial Business</b>	
Mechanical Container	\$3.41 per cubic yard
Compactor Container	\$4.37 per cubic yard
One 64-gallon cart serviced two times per week	\$14.05 per month
One 96-gallon cart serviced two times per week	\$21.09 per month
Two 96-gallon carts services two times per week	\$41.41 per month

**Roll-off Containers:** Charges may be negotiated with the Customer, but in no case shall they exceed the following:

Open Top Type (per collection)	
15 cubic yards	\$260.53
20 cubic yards	\$335.58
30 cubic yards	\$375.81
40 cubic yards	\$389.52

Enclosed Compactor	
15 cubic yards	\$261.26
20 cubic yards	\$263.11
30 cubic yards	\$321.46
40 cubic yards	\$325.18


Above open-top and compactor rates are based on disposal at the Brevard County disposal site on Sarno Road and do not include taxes, leasing/maintenance fees and disposal fees. The Contractor is authorized to charge an additional fee of up to \$92.00 per trip should disposal at the Brevard County disposal site in Cocoa, Florida be required.

SECTION 2. That the rates as provided in this resolution shall be effective on billings made on or after October 1, 2011.


SECTION 3. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
