Summary of the Proposed Ordinance

At its November 13, 2025 regular meeting City Council gave the City Attorney direction to revise City Code pursuant to guidance provided on public participation and standards of decorum at City Council meetings. The proposed ordinance is submitted to City Council pursuant to this direction in furtherance of servicing the public health, safety, morals and welfare.
