

A how-to guide to prepare Yard Waste for Curbside Collection.



IMPORTANT REMINDERS for curbside collection

- Please **DO NOT** bag containerized yard waste
- Containerized yard waste and small piles **must be curbside** by **6:00 a.m.** on your collection day
- **Large, loose** yard waste piles are collected on a separate day
- To better serve you, we encourage customers to contact WM's **Customer Service** for collection of large, loose yard waste piles

DO this:



LOOSE MATERIALS

Use a **40 gallon can**, **not to exceed 50 pounds in weight**, for pine needles, leaves, small twigs, palm fronds and tree/shrub trimmings.



BRANCHES / LIMBS

Place branches and limbs in a small pile in a **uniform pattern**.



LENGTH/DIAMETER

Ensure yard waste is **no greater** than 4 feet in **length** and 24 inches in **diameter**.

NOT this:



DO NOT bag yard waste.



DO NOT put branches and limbs in different directions.



DO NOT have piles larger than 4 feet in length.

DID YOU KNOW?
